Students come to class prepared with all their materials:

- ✓ 2 inch binder
- √ 1 Exercise book
- ✓ 4 dividers labeled: Notes, Worksheets, Labs and Evaluations
- ✓ Pencils, pens, eraser and ruler
- ✓ Coloring pencils and/or markers
- ✓ Calculator
- √ Loose leaf

Evaluation:

- The course is evaluated using 2 competencies: C1 Practical (Labs) worth 40% and C2 - Knowledge (assignments, projects, quizzes, tests, exams) worth 60%
- Science department policies:
 - ❖ An assignment can be 2 days late without penalty, after this they will lose 10% per day for up to 3 days later, weekends included.
 - Extended time is factored into assignments and projects.
 - NO re-tests are given.
 - ❖ Students are prohibited of bringing any electronics to class for the entire period of a test/exam. Students will be reminded not to bring an electronic to class and they will have to sign on the evaluation that they do not have an electronic with them. If a child does bring an electronic to class, they will get a zero. This is the same rule that the ministry applies for the June exams
